


The Elephant Group

The Mission - 'Top 3rd for the Top 3rd'

Today in the UK, it remains the case that access to the most selective universities is significantly determined by family income. As the Office for Students reports:



The Elephant Group was formed in 2018 with the ambition to increase access to 'top third' universities for the 'top third' students from non-selective state schools.

Today, The Elephant Group is a partnership of regional school leaders, teachers, universities, industry and third sector partners united in their support for fair access.

Currently we have developed two bespoke high impact programmes:

Elephant Access – Our flagship programme is delivered with secondary schools through a blend of skills workshops, online seminars, visits and a summer school. We support students to aspire to, apply for and attain access top tier universities, working collaboratively with our partner universities.

Meta Method is our new innovative schools programme, supporting young people in their studies. Meta Method has huge potential to grow rapidly in scale and audience.

- Lead monitoring and evaluation processes, working to assess programme impact and refine delivery.
- Manage programme budgets, ensuring financial accountability and providing regular updates to the CEO.

- Develop and implement strategies to enhance programme quality, reach, and impact.
- Use all forms of information provision to continually improve programmes and measure programme efficacy.
- Develop clear project plans for all programmes ensuring smooth delivery.
